Great Location, and a Great Value

The Fall Press Day Conference is held at the Busch Campus Center, Rutgers University, 604 Bartholomew Road, Piscataway, NJ 08854, conveniently accessible from Routes 1, 18 and 287, the NJ Turnpike and the Garden State Parkway.

The cost of the conference is reasonable: just \$20 per student and \$50 per adviser, which includes a one-year GSSPA membership.
